# Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive Intersection Upgrade

**Project update** 

We're upgrading the intersection at Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive to make your journey safer and more reliable.

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$85 million (50:50) towards an upgrade of the intersection of Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive.

## What's happening

Construction works to upgrade the Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive intersection are progressing well, with major construction to be complete in early 2026.

Activities will continue to increase and include service relocation works, kerbing and median removal, drainage works, installation of conduits for road lighting electrical infrastructure, landscaping irrigation, pavement rehabilitation, asphalting and footpath reinstatement.

Additionally, the existing flashing light crossing on the southern side of the intersection on Marion Road (north of Jenkins Street) will be upgraded to a Pedestrian Actuated Crossing (PAC).

The PAC will be a signalised pedestrian crossing where people activate the crossing lights by pressing a button. This improvement will enhance safety for pedestrians by providing safer access to local shops, schools and bus services.

To ensure the work can be done safely, and to minimise the impact to road users, the majority of work will be done at night.

## How this affects you

The Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive intersection will remain open to traffic during these works.

To keep everyone safe speed and lane restrictions will be in place as required. Please follow traffic management and onsite signage. Intermittent temporary closures of side streets within the construction zones on all approaches to the intersection of Sir Donald Bradman Drive and Marion Road will be required, with local signage in place to direct road users.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons, there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Access to businesses and properties will be maintained at all times. If there is a need for short-term access impacts, we will contact you directly in advance.

Some noise disturbance can be expected; however, we will minimise as much as practically possible.

We encourage you to register to receive project updates and stay up to date as the project progresses using the above contact details overleaf.

Bus Stops 7 (north and south sides of Sir Donald Bradman Drive) will remain temporarily closed for the duration of the project. Please use Bus Stops 8, located 300m west of the closed stops. ### Service relocation works

#### Telecommunications (Telstra, NBN Co and Vocus)

Telecommunication service relocation works are continuing during both the day and night. These activities are planned to be complete by the end March 2025, weather permitting.

During these works, there may be temporary outages. Telecommunication providers will directly notify properties in advance if a minor outage is required.

There may also be intermittent temporary access restrictions for these works including Western Parade, Raws Road and Spencer Street. Please follow traffic management directions and onsite signage while works are in progress.

#### **SA Water**

SA Water will continue to undertake minor water and sewer relocation works. These activities are planned to be complete by early March 2025, weather permitting.

During these works, there may be short term water outages. SA Water will directly notify properties in advance if a service outage is needed.
