







This is the City of West Torrens Civic Centre. It is located at 165 Sir Donald Bradman Drive, Hilton 5033.


There is a bus stop nearby on Sir Donald Bradman Drive.




This is the building entrance from Sir Donald Bradman Drive.



There is a carpark behind the Civic Centre that you can access from Brooker Terrace. There are accessible parking spaces close to the entrance.




This is where you enter the Civic Centre from the car park. There are signs telling you where to go.




This is the Civic Centre foyer. There is an access ramp and more signs telling you where to go.



This is the entrance to the Council chamber.




You can talk to someone at the Civic Centre about rates, animals, rubbish, trees and other council services.




This is the customer service counter.


There are communication tools available.




Next to the service counter is a public computer. You can use this to pay for your rates, dog registration and to access the PlanSA website.
