The Hamra Centre Library address is 1 Brooker Terrace, Hilton 5033.




You can check the Hamra Centre Library <u>website</u> for opening hours.



There is a carpark on the corner of Brooker Terrace and Davenport Terrace.




In the carpark there is a chute where you can return items.










There is an online library that you can access too. This includes eBooks, audiobooks, eMagazines, eNewspapers, online learning, family history, music, videos and TV shows.






We have computers at the library that you can use and free Wi-Fi. You can also print, scan and copy your documents.




You can see a Justice of the Peace to get your documents signed or looked at.



The library has a children's area.






There is a free Toy Library too.

There is also free cold filtered water available.






There are also many free programs and events at the library that you can come to. These include English classes and tech help sessions.
